

Videotaping the ISCBS Play Sample Protocol



Administration of the ISCBS needs to be videotaped in order to review for scoring and coding purposes.

Have the following materials ready before you begin taping:

- Video equipment charged and ready
- Tripod
- Toy kit
- *ISCBS Play Sample Protocol* form and pencil

The ISCBS should be administered with you and the family on the floor, which should be clear from other toys and distractions. When recording, the child and the adult interacting with the child both need to be included. Faces of the child and adult must be visible as behaviors such as eye gaze and eye gaze shifts will be scored and coded at a later time. The child's upper body and hands also need to be visible for coding and scoring purposes. The camera must be monitored and adjusted throughout the administration session to accommodate mobile children and changes in position.
